Date Assessed	Goal
	The dog will maintain a 'watch me' from 4 feet with a person walking around the trainer making a noise
	The dog will respond to its name from 15 feet with a noise and person making a distraction
	The dog can be put into a 'sit' by the owner when the dog is busy, owner calls the dog's name and cues 'sit' from 10 feet away
	The dog can be put into a 'down' by the owner when the dog is busy, owner calls the dog's name and cues down from 10 feet away
	The dog will maintain a 'sit' or 'down' position with the owner 15 feet away for 1 minute
	The dog will heel to the owner for 15 paces in three directions with no lure
	The dog will recall to the owner from the 'sit' or 'down' maintain criteria at 20 feet with a verbal distraction of somebody else calling the dog from the opposite direction
	The owner having cue'd a 'sit' position can step into 'heel' position without the dog moving
	The dog will stand from a 'sit' or a 'down' using both a verbal and a physical cue from 6 feet away
	The dog can go into a 'down' position with the owner giving the cue from 10 feet away
	The dog can 'sit' from a 'down' position with the owner giving the cue from 10 feet away
	The dog responds to an "emergency" wait cue and stops in its tracks with the owner 10 feet away
	The owner can place the dog in a 'down maintain' position and move out of sight for 1 minute
	The dog should be able to discriminate the release cue 'okay' and only release from a maintain when they hear this
